

PRESERVATION MINOR

Students in the undergraduate Minor in Preservation Studies program master fundamentals of historic preservation practice through courses in theory and practice, building technology, and architectural history. Preservation Studies students meet experts in the field and often work with organizations engaged in historic preservation projects and advocacy. Courses require fieldwork that may include regional site visits.
