

# HOSPITALITY ENTREPRENEURSHIP CERTIFICATE

## Overview

**This certificate will be available to BSM students in the Spring 2024 when the first course of the certificate is expected to be offered.**

A Certificate in Hospitality Entrepreneurship will provide students with a well-rounded education in hospitality entrepreneurship, equipping them with the necessary knowledge, skills, and competencies to thrive in various roles in the hospitality industry.

## Requirements

The Certificate in Hospitality Entrepreneurship will be awarded to those undergraduate students within the Freeman School who successfully complete twelve (12) credit hours in the following four courses:

- MGMT 4001 – Entrepreneurial Hospitality
- MGMT 4190 – Managing Hospitality Organizations
- LGST 4170 – Employment Law
- MGMT 4310 – Cases in Hospitality

The certificate must be earned concurrently with the undergraduate degree. No more than one course from the certificate may overlap with a student's B.S.M. degree requirements.
