

K-12 EDUCATION LEADERSHIP CERTIFICATE (GRADUATE)

Overview

Students who receive a graduate certificate in K-12 Education Leadership will be prepared to act in leadership roles in the K-12 sector. Courses from this graduate-level “stackable” certificate program are a part of the Master of Public Administration program at SoPA; students may take an additional eight courses, including seven required courses, to earn the full MPA degree.
